Upptäckten av de först kända, moderna amfibierna i Antarktis ger ytterligare bevis för ett varmt och tempererat klimat på den antarktiska halvön innan den separerades från den sydliga superkontinenten Gondwana. Fossilerna, som tillhör familjen hjälmgrodor beskrivs i Scientific Reports. Research news from the Rossby Centre: North pole soon to be ice free in summer

Researchers from the Bolin Centre partner SMHI Rossby Centre have contributed [to a new study](#). The study finds that Arctic summer sea ice disappears occasionally even if CO2 emissions are rapidly reduced. This really surprised the reserachers.
